During their talks, the two heads of state called for the adoption at the COP21 in Paris, of an ambitious agreement. They reiterated their common will to contribute to calming the situation in the east of Ukraine by continuing their complementary mediation efforts between Ukraine and Russia. They also reaffirmed their determination to act against terrorism.

The two Presidents also worked to strengthen the strategic partnership between France and Kazakhstan. They notably discussed the priority areas of energy, aeronautics and space. The following documents were signed in presence of the two heads of state:-----
